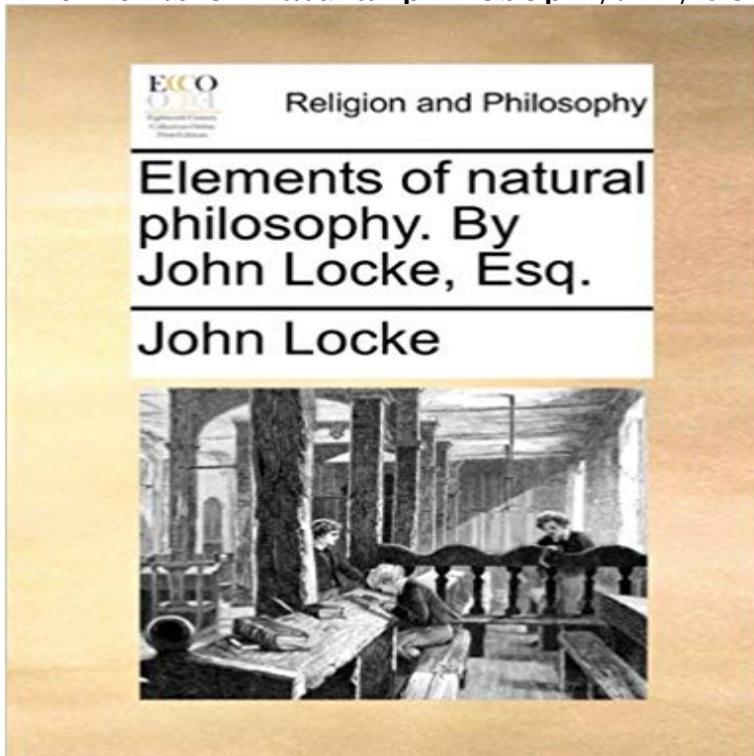


Elements of natural philosophy. By John Locke, Esq.
